COVID-19 “coronavirus” PREPAREDNESS ACTION

As an active member of our community, Valley Ridge Construction is doing our part in the current nationwide pandemic crisis, by following the recommendations and precautions laid out by the CDC, “Center for Disease Control”. We also remain committed to our neighbors by continuing to provide our services to keep your homes safe and dry with needed repairs and new roofs when needed. The storm season is upon us and we feel our services are more in need than ever as we face new challenges.

Our employees have been educated and instructed to follow these precautions:

- **Wash your hands** often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, **use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol**. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- **Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth** with unwashed hands.
- **Avoid close contact** with people who are sick
- Put **distance between yourself and other people** – at least 6 feet when possible.
- **Stay home** if you are sick, except to get medical care. Learn [what to do if you are sick](#).
- **Cover your mouth and nose** with a tissue when you cough or sneeze or use the inside of your elbow.
- **Throw used tissues** in the trash
- **If you are NOT sick:** You do not need to wear a facemask unless you are caring for someone who is sick (and they are not able to wear a facemask). Facemasks may be in short supply and they should be saved for caregivers.
- **Clean AND disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily.** This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.
- **If surfaces are dirty, clean them:** Use detergent or soap and water prior to disinfection.

We have also developed a method for “**Zero Contact Inspections**”. Those in need of roof inspections and repairs, may electronically, by “face-time” or by phone conversations, authorize our inspectors and installers to access roofs. We will then electronically deliver our findings. Simply put, there will be no need to meet in person for inspections, repairs, or paperwork throughout the entire process. unless we are requested by the homeowner to do so.

Along with everyone else, we will continue to learn and adapt as needed. As new information is released by the CDC and our local officials, we will abide and adjust. We will work together to help end this difficult time.
